an excellent harvest (crop).

♦ This wine is a profoundly saturated blue/black with aromas of violets and blackberries exuding from the glass. On the palate it reveals richness wrapped with black cherry, vanilla and dark chocolate. Traces of earth and cedar complete this intriguing "cabernet lover's merlot" with firm yet silky tannins and a heady finish. This is a massive yet supple and stylish wine to enjoy for years to come.
